History

Until the New Shuttle came into operation, the local communities had to rely on buses as there were delays in setting up transportation systems despite the area's favorable location of approximately 40km from central Tokyo. However when the Tohoku/Joetsu Shinkansen track was constructed in the Omiya (now Saitama), Ageo and Ina areas, the New Shuttle was set up as a new transit system intended to stimulate regional development along the railway line and to serve as a means of transport for local inhabitants. It came into operation on December 22, 1983.
